OLYMPIC GAMES

At first Olympic Games were religious festivals in ancient Greece. The most famous of these festivals was at Olympia honor of the Greek god Zeus. The first competition was in 776 B.C. and the last one in 393 A.D.

In 1896, a Frenchman, Baron Pierre de Coubertin organized the first Olympics of modern times in Athens, Greece. Since then, every four years the best amateur athletes compete in a variety of sports played in at least twenty-five countries to be eligible. Nowadays there are the Summer Olympic Games and The Winter Olympic Games which take place in the same year.

The president or the king of the host country declares the games officially open and a runner enters the stadium, with a torch that comes from Olympia, and lights the olympic flame that is going to burn until the end of the games.

In the closing ceremony all the athletes parade into the stadium mixed, without to regard to nationality, as a symbol of Olympic friendship.
